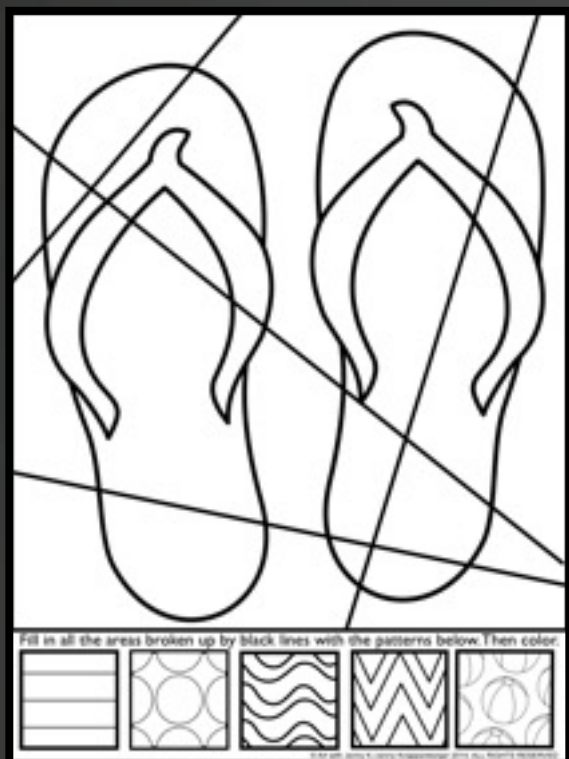


# Interactive Coloring Sheets

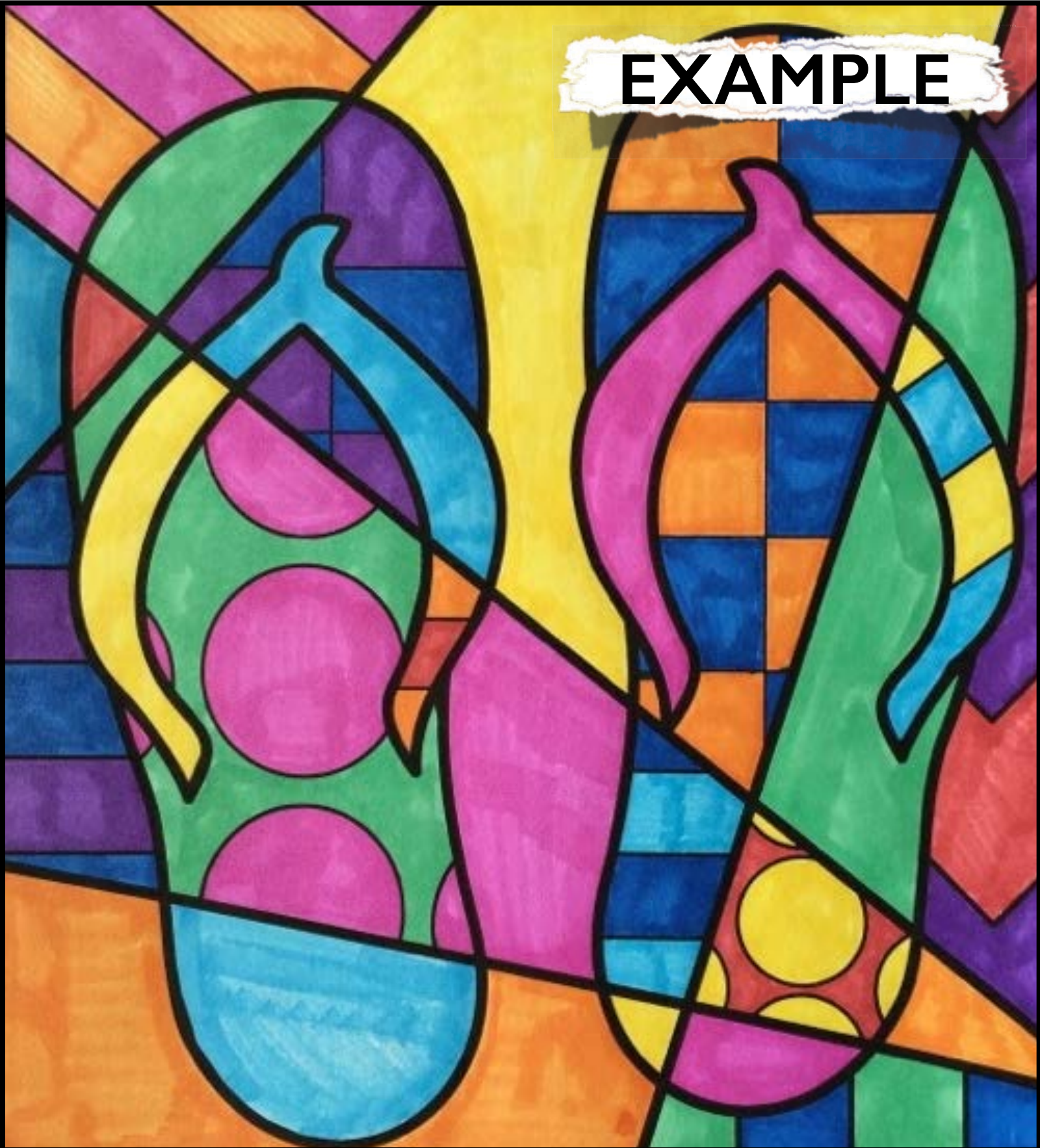


2. Color all the shapes and patterns. Use crayons, colored pencils or markers.

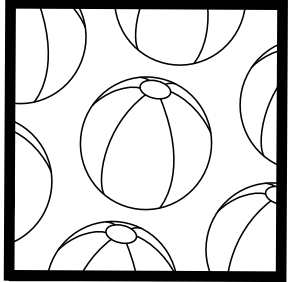
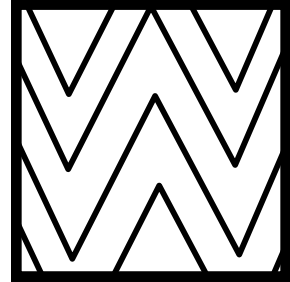
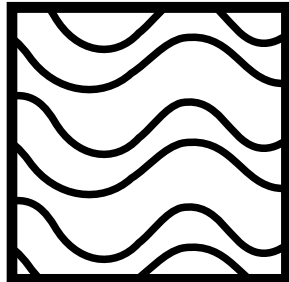
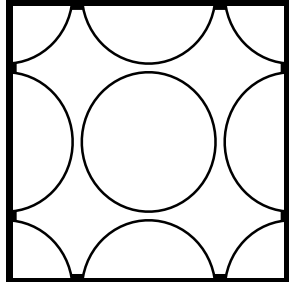
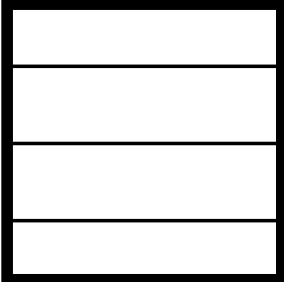
3. Cut out the large rectangle at the top with the finished work. Display for all to see!



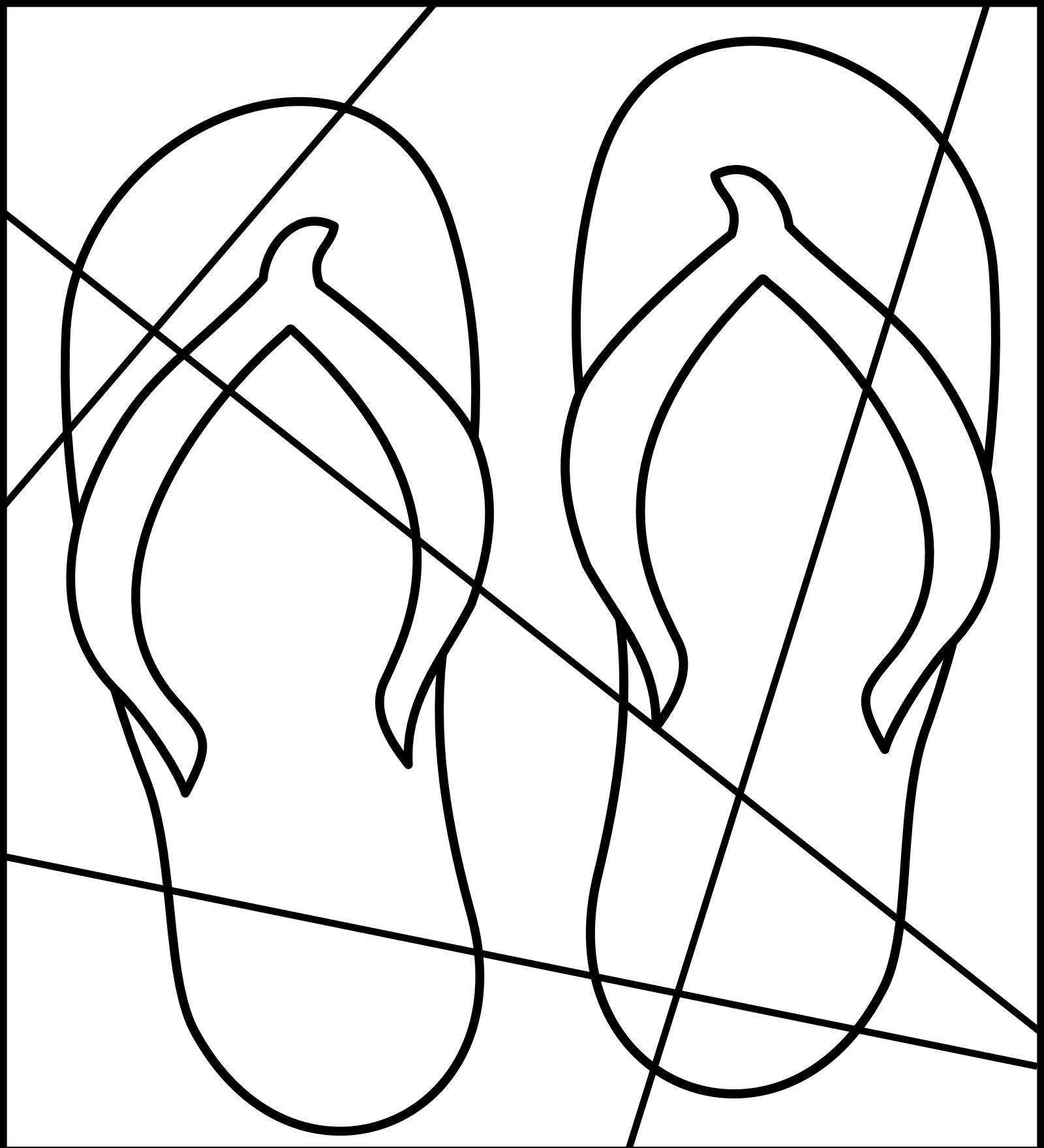
